

## **Nurtec ODT – Pfizer**

Pfizer announced a consumer-level recall of Nurtec ODT (rimegepant) 75 mg orally disintegrating tablets sold in cartons containing one blister card of 8 tablets because the tablets are in a non-child resistant blister card. There are no safety or quality issues with the medicine, so patients can continue taking it as directed. Patients are being asked to contact their pharmacy or Pfizer to obtain a free, child-resistant pouch.
