



The percentage of members ages 20 to 44 who received a preventative health or ambulatory visit within the past three years.




Adult's Access (ages 45 to 64) to Preventative or Ambulatory Health Services

The percentage of members ages 45 to 64 who received a preventative health or ambulatory visit within the past three years.




Adult's Access (ages 65+) to Preventative or Ambulatory Health Services

The percentage of members ages 65+ who received a preventative health or ambulatory visit within the past three years.
























